EMERGENCY ORDINANCE 2020-07 OF THE BRISTOL BAY BOROUGH ASSEMBLY

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE BRISTOL BAY BOROUGH ESTABLISHING A COVID-19 ACCOUNT IN THE FY20 AND FY 21 BUDGETS, AND APPROPRIATING \$50,000 FOR THE FY20 COVID-19 ACCOUNT.

WHEREAS, COVID-19 is a respiratory disease that can result in serious illness or death and is caused by the SARS-Cov-2 virus ("virus"), a new strain of the coronavirus that has not been previously identified in humans and is easily transmittable person to person; and

WHEREAS, on March 24, 2020 the Assembly declared a State of Emergency in the Borough, and appointed the Borough Manager Incident Commander for the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Manager must start immediately to set up an Emergency Operations Center (EOC), as provided by the Borough Emergency Operating Plan, and otherwise prepare the Borough government to manage its affairs during the period of the declaration of emergency; and


WHEREAS, these preparations require the expenditure of Borough funds that may be reimbursable by the State or Federal governments, including FEMA, in that the expenditures are made for these purposes and under the Borough's Declaration of a State of Emergency; and


WHEREAS, the Borough's ability to obtain state or federal reimbursement for spending funds on these emergency preparations and emergency management activities may depend, in part, upon the Borough keeping an complete and accurate accounting of expenditures of Borough funds for these purposes; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE BRISTOL BAY BOROUGH that, pursuant to the emergency ordinance section of Borough Code 1.12.050, the Assembly here establishes a Covid-19 account in the Borough Manager's FY20 and FY21 budgets; and

THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE BRISTOL BAY BOROUGH that the Assembly appropriates \$50,000 to the Manager's FY20 Covid-19 budget account for expenditures related to the Borough's Covid-19 operations and to setting up the EOC.
