**PROPOSITION NO. 1**

**NEW 1.5% TAX ON THE VALUE OF ALL FINFISH, SHELLFISH, AND FISH BYPRODUCTS PROCESSED BY SHORE-BASED, FLOATING, AND DIRECT MARKETING SEAFOOD PROCESSORS.**

This proposition would amend the Bristol Bay Borough Code by adding a new Chapter 3.18, and thereby create a new 1.5% Borough tax on the value of all finfish, shellfish, and fish byproducts that are processed by shore-based, floating, and direct marketing seafood processors.

If approved by a majority of voters who vote on the question at the November 5, 2019 Special Election, Chapter 3.18 of the Bristol Bay Borough Code, and the new tax it creates, shall become effective 30 days following the election, and shall automatically expire on April 30, 2026 unless renewed by the Bristol Bay Borough Assembly.
